

Family Faith Walk

Read together Matthew 13:3-9 and 18-23

Faith Walk:

Put on two pairs of socks – the second pair should be older socks that you are with ruining. Walk to a park and take off your shoes. Walk around for several minutes. Take off the top pair of socks, put your shoes on and walk home. At home, dampen each dirty sock with water, place them in individual zipper bags, cut triangles in the bottom of the bags, and set them in a sunny window. Over the next week, observe the zipper bags and discover what happens to them.

Faith Talk:

1. How are some people like the seed sown on the path?
2. Why does the seed sown among the rocks spring up quickly and then die?
How are some people like that?
3. How can you be like a seed sown on good soil? Hint: Read John 15:5.
4. What crop will you produce?

Pray:

Dear God, prepare in our hearts good soil so when the seed of Your Word is planted, our faith may grow. Please help us to plant Your Word into the soil of other people's hearts as we share the Good News of Jesus with them. In His name, Amen.
